

Active Imagination:

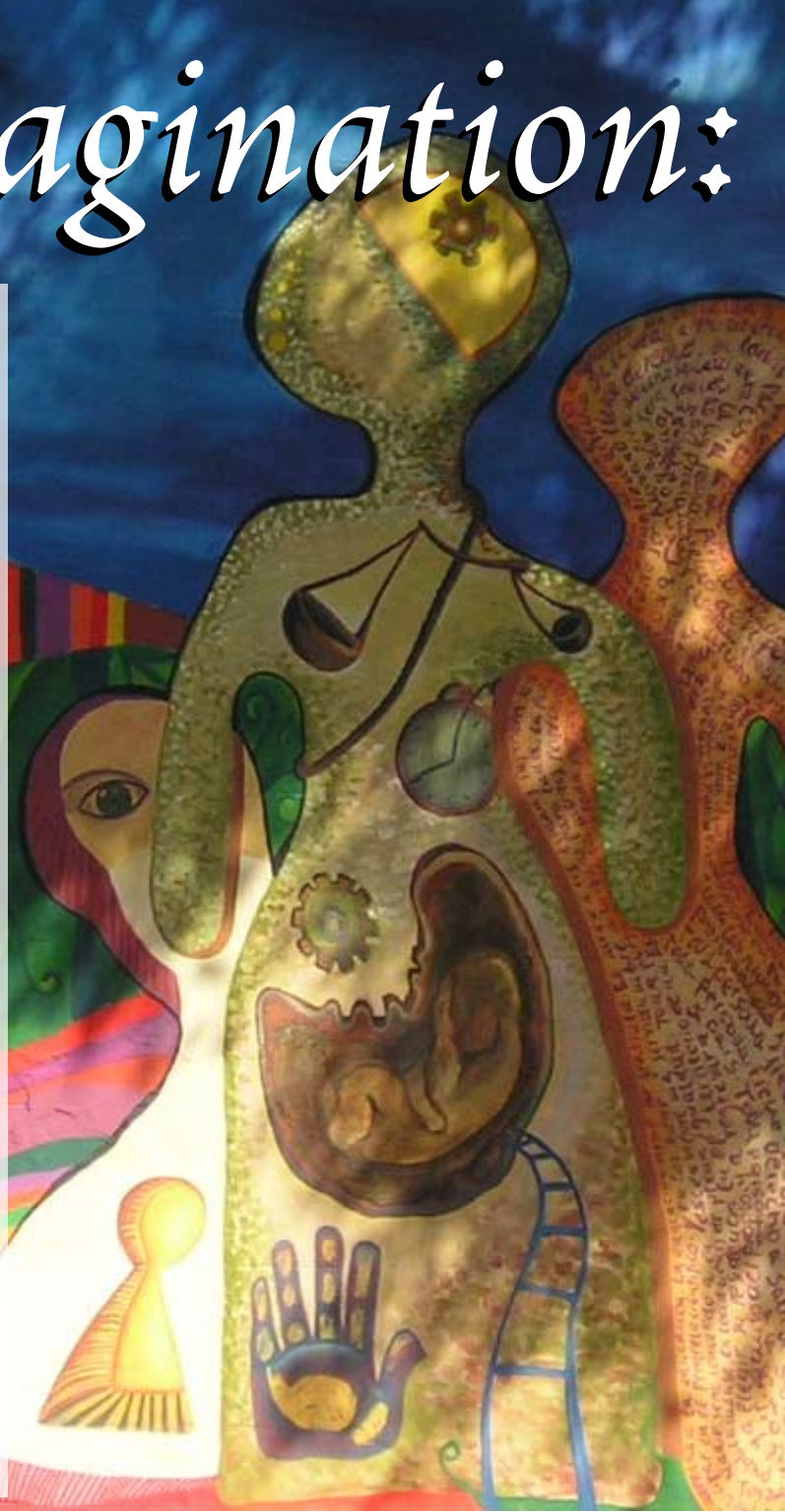
